

VOLUNTEER: Project up date 06 August 2017.

You may have been wondering what has been going on over the last few weeks.



Work has continued in marking up the map sheets identifying routes of interest, in general we will refer to them as "Route Anomalies", around 75% of the map sheets are now marked up.

What has become clear, during the marking up process, is that there are a large number of "Route Anomalies", not all of which would warrant a full scale investigation and therefore there is a need to introduce an extra step in our original proposals.

It is intended that that "Route Anomalies" will be subject to a "Preliminary Field Survey" to identify what is on the ground, any evidence of use by the public and how what you see compares with the Definitive Map, and the Map Statements.



The Survey(s) will be run on a template which will provide you with relevant marked DM copy, Map Statements and key headings under which to record your findings, photographs and other mapping information.

This data will assist us in determining which of the "Route Anomalies" are suitable Lost Ways Candidates and therefore would go forward for more in depth research and will form part of the a Candidate Route Dossier.



A short launch meeting for volunteers has been arranged (about 2½ hours) for 7th September 2017 at 1900hrs at Horton Kirby Village Hall to explain the Preliminary Field Survey process and to answer any questions.
