



Kent Ramblers: Sector Coordinator: Job Description

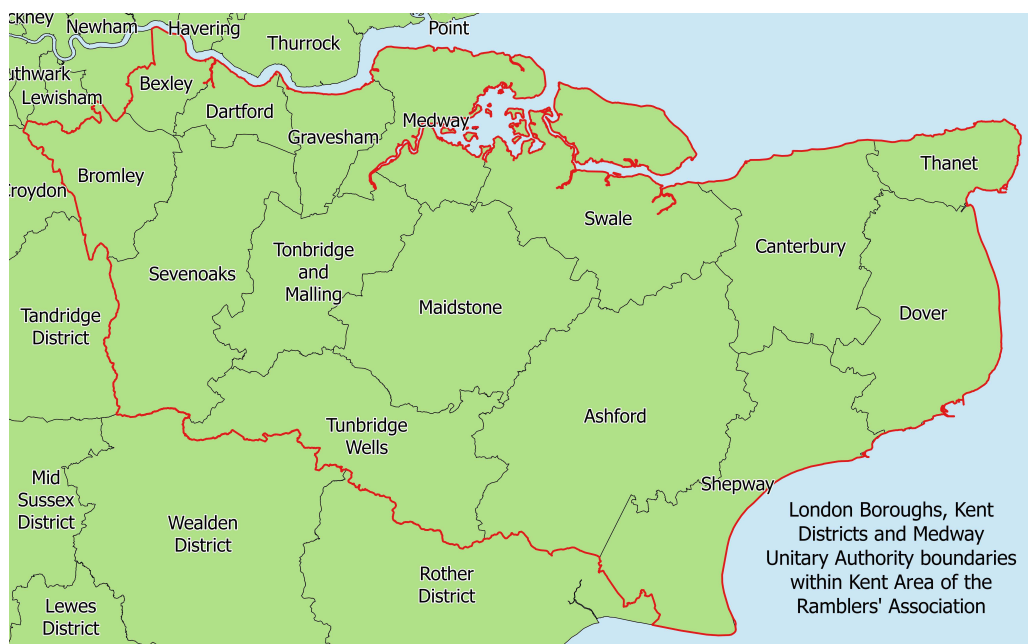
There are four Sector Coordinators – two covering West Kent and two covering East Kent.

The main duties of this key role are to support, advise as required, circulate information and regularly liaise with their network of Local Footpath Officers (typically nine or so) and assist with or take on the more difficult cases. Good organisational and interpersonal skills are desirable. Coordinators will jointly organise and chair quarterly meetings for all Local FP Officers in their half of Kent, including meetings with KCC management. They are members of Kent Area Council.

It is useful, but not essential, for Coordinators to have prior experience of rights of way work with the Ramblers.

There is currently a vacancy for one of the East Kent Coordinators covering the Ashford and Swale District Council areas plus Romney Marsh (the exact area may be negotiable – smaller, for example – to suit the individual).
